We finish back in Delhi, with a guided tour of one of the Seven Wonders of the World — the glorious Taj Mahal.



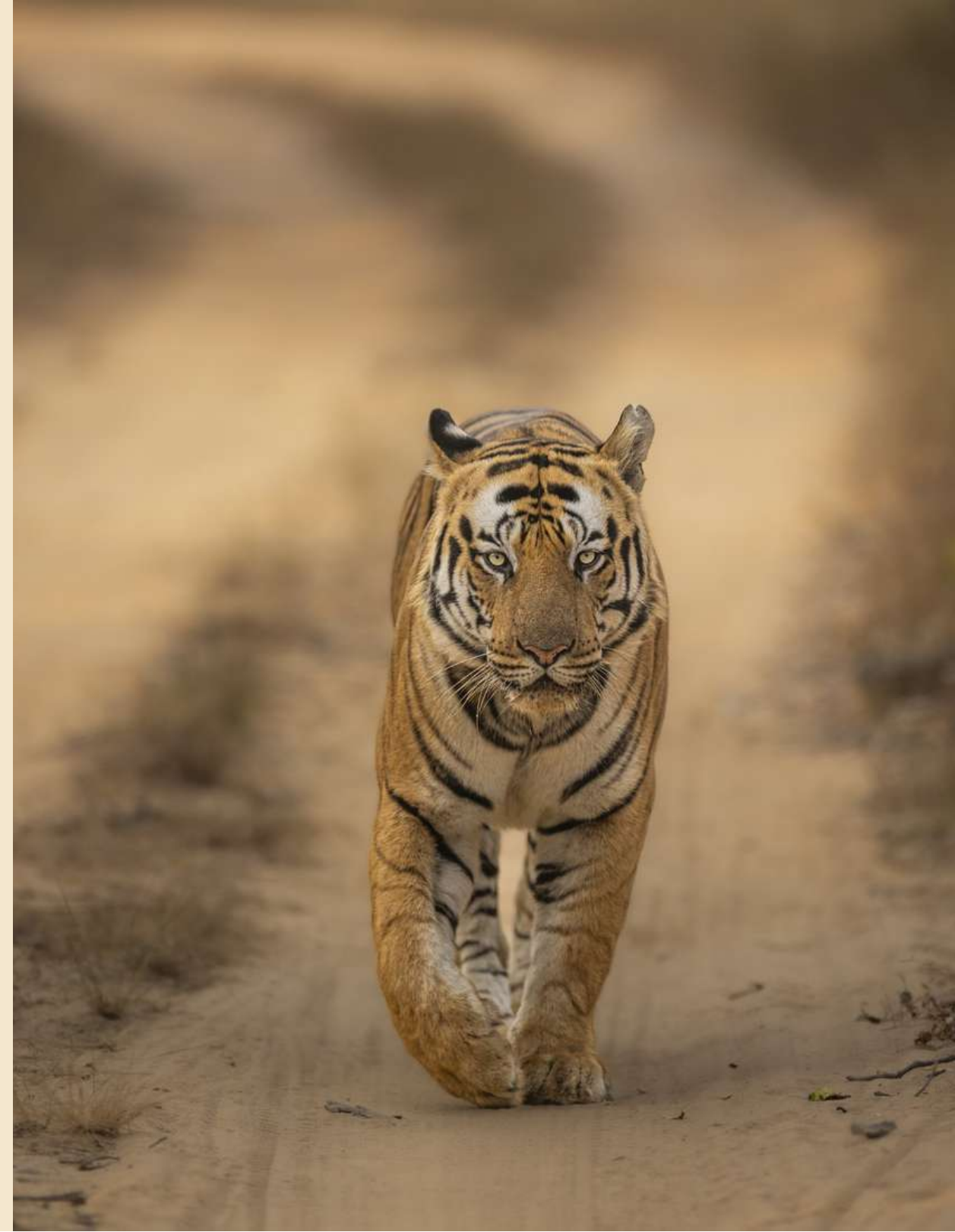
NATIONAL PARK

Bandhavgarh

Famed for its high density of tigers, and now home to the park's newest residents — herds of Asian elephants — alongside sloth bears, leopards and a plethora of herbivore species.

The terrain ranges from grasslands to rocky outcrops and boulders, an ancient temple statue and rivers. Bandhavgarh offers ample opportunity to watch and photograph tigers as they patrol their territories.

TIGER RESERVE

Kanha

Kanha Tiger Reserve holds populations of Bengal tiger, Indian leopard, dhole, sloth bear, Bengal fox, golden jackal and the incredible barasingha — the hard-ground swamp deer found nowhere else on earth. The reserve also hosts around 300 species of birds.

Kanha is known for its rolling meadows and grasslands, which make for exciting photographic opportunities.

New Delhi to Jabalpur

After a good night's sleep and a nice lazy morning, we make our way to the airport by hotel transfer to catch our flight to Jabalpur. There you'll be met by the ground transfers that bring you to Bandhavgarh National Park.

Meet your guide and host at the lodge, get acquainted, and be briefed on the safari days ahead.

Flight — 1 hour 30 minutes

Drive — 3 hours 30 minutes

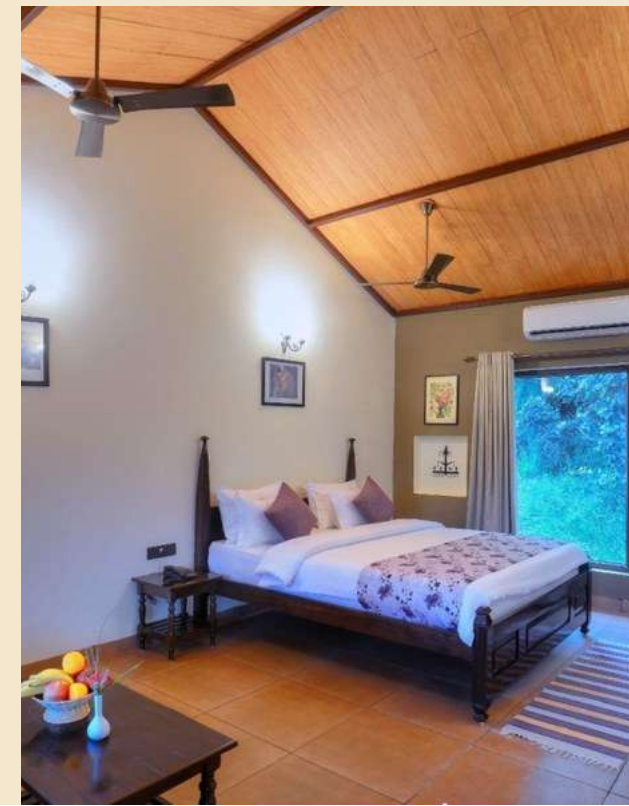

TERMS AT A GLANCE

AWE

PAYMENT

- A 50% deposit confirms your journey.
- The balance is due 90 days before your first day.
- Card payments carry a 4% service fee.

IF PLANS CHANGE

- We understand plans change — but permits and bookings are made in your name and can't be passed on, so the deposit isn't refundable.
- Cancel 60–89 days before your first day: 25% of the price comes back. 45–59 days: 12.5%. Under 45 days: nothing.
- If we cancel, everything you have paid comes back.

BEFORE YOU TRAVEL

- Travel insurance is strongly recommended in India, and required for journeys abroad.
- Wildlife is wild. Sightings are never guaranteed.
- Park rules are the law — your guide will tell you what applies.
